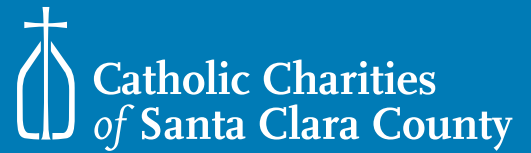


Disaster Recovery Services San Jose Flood **UPDATE**



WHAT WE'VE DONE

To date, Catholic Charities of Santa Clara County has served 235 households, 703 individuals.

- › Total households currently in temporary housing: 18

- › Total households returned to formerly flooded address: 149
- › Total individuals returned to formerly flooded address: 466
- › Total households moved to new permanent housing: 68
- › Total individuals moved to new permanent housing: 195
- › Total individuals assisted with car or car repair: 86
